Vendor Standards

1. All vendors may only sell what they produce.
2. Vendors must produce their work within 70 miles of Norwood and within the state of North Carolina.
3. Farm Vendors must own or lease the land on which they produce their crops.
4. Farm Vendors must preside over the production of the crops they sell at the Market.
5. Vendors must have all necessary licenses and insurances required by the Federal, State, and Local Governments to produce, handle, and transport their items.
6. Vendors must adhere to all procedures laid out in the Rules & Regulations.

Application Criteria

- Does the applicant offer a unique product made in North Carolina?
- Will the vendor fill a useful niche in the Market as a whole?
- Is the product underrepresented in the market?
- Will the applicant help elevate the Market and the community at large?
- Will the owner/key producer have a consistent presence at the Market?
- Does the application reflect a professional and clear approach to the business of selling at the market?
- Does the applicant fit into the Market's goal to support the community through access to farm-fresh products and handmade local goods?
- Will the applicant add to the spirit of cooperation expected in the Market community?
- Is the applicant flexible for last minute changes due to unforeseen circumstances?
